(3)	Timing must conform to <b>Rule 165.</b> If Manual timing is used, <b>three</b> times must be lodged. If fully automatic Gate Timing or Photo Finish is used, only one time needs to be lodged with the claim form for the VBP to be accepted.				
(4)	The necessary Results Sheets were signed by the Chief Photo Finish Operator or the Chief Timekeeper and the Referee of the event.				
(5)	A VBP will only be recognised for the Athlete who is first across the finish line.				
	nand timed performances, the performance will be rounded to 0.1 seconds and then dardised to align to a fully automatic time as follows:				
	<ul> <li>Distances under 400m: + 0.24 seconds</li> <li>Distances of 400m or 4x100m relay: + 0.14 seconds</li> <li>Distances greater than 400m: No change</li> <li>a standardised time will be indicated with {S} or similar</li> </ul>				



**Note:** As of August 2014 all existing VBP Track performances have been be standardised using the formulas and whichever of the standardised hand time or Fully Automatic Time performance is lower have been declared the VBP.

## For Field events:

- (6) All distances and heights must be checked and the recording sheet signed by the Chief Judge and Referee.
- (7) All implements and measuring apparatus must be verified by LAVic for compliance to be included in the pool of available equipment.
- (8) The recording of a VBP requires the Referee to check the manner in which the trial is measured is correct and to verify the measurement of the trial using a certified tape, except where an EDM is being used.
- (9) Where the measurement of a Long / Triple Jump is within 5cm or any Throw is within 10cm of the VBP for that event, the measurement must be checked using a certified tape, except where an EDM is being used.
- (10) The claiming Region Secretary / Organising Secretary shall forward the claim form to the LAVic Office within fourteen (14) days after the event, complete with all documentary evidence.

Please forward copies of all certificates (ground surveys, watches), result sheets and timekeeper slips for verification. These will be kept by the LAVic. Originals are to be retained by the Region.
